3. Did you attend or graduate from any other schools after leaving Carlisle? No. Give names of schools and dates if possible

4. What is your present occupation? Farmer

5. Tell something of your present home. my home is of frame building of 3 rooms, 14x16 and one <sup>front</sup> room is 12x14, 8 1/2 ft wall. The house is painted white with two large cottage windows. porch all around front, East and back and two glass doors. This is the description of my home. My family consist of three children besides my wife and myself. I have also on the place barn, chicken house, wind mill and whole lot of other things to make a home near Chickasha Okla; Have two buildings in area, city area. Have 8 head of work horses, 2 cows, 30 head of hogs and about 66 ponies.

6. What property in the way of land, stock, buildings, or money do you have? I have 160 acres of land near Chickasha Okla; Have two buildings in area, city area. Have 8 head of work horses, 2 cows, 30 head of hogs and about 66 ponies. Have about 700.00 in bank at present

7. Have you been in the Indian Service? In what positions? How long in each? yes, I have been at old Keweenaw school for about a year. Farmer two years at Rainy Mt school and act as interpreter for Agents Macken, Able and Mayor Baldwin

8. What other positions have you held since leaving Carlisle? *Have ~~not~~ work  
in stores of different practices in town*

9. Tell me anything else of interest connected with your life:

*When I left school I was full  
of life to succeed because I was strong and thought I  
could overcome any thing in the way of  
temptation and not get discouraged but it wasn't  
very long until a person find out, or at least I did, for  
I have seen my ups and downs, but I am glad to-day  
as I am filling this here Blank I can say that I am  
not ashamed that I was a student of Carlisle once and  
hope Carlisle will not be disgrace by me for any  
of my doings.  
I am farming this spring 20 acres of land plenty  
to eat and plenty respect for Carlisle to let these  
white people around <sup>here</sup> say that an ex student from  
Carlisle wouldnt farm. My crop is looking  
find since the rain. Hope this will be help to  
some boys or girls for I have fail once but I am on my  
feet again because I never got discouraged all at once  
when things didnt go just right but <sup>the</sup> more encourage-  
ment I had when I have <sup>the</sup> blyes and that is three words  
come across my mind. What Carlisle <sup>is</sup> if you were  
you left it, and it has always help me to fight for the
