Its with a great

Willcom letters which came to me a  
few day ago. and in reply I will say  
that I will try and send you my photograph  
as soon as I will be able to do so. I would be  
glad to <sup>send</sup> you one but I have <sup>been</sup> on the sick  
list now for quite a <sup>and</sup> while there for I  
am not to able <sup>to</sup> have one taken at present and  
about my school mates which were with  
me at Carlisle school I know of two of  
them boys that - they are making good of  
them for <sup>what</sup> they learned at school there  
and the boys are working at the Government  
mill and they are doing very well at present



In fact I will say all the boys that  
been to school at Caplice they all have  
good living but all <sup>the</sup> trouble is that the  
white people are afraid of them on account  
they that the Indians might know to  
much for them if the Indian had the ~~to~~  
chance <sup>to work</sup> for the Government on our Reserve I  
think that they would not be so much  
Robbery done as there at present and  
that is the great reason why a Indian cannot  
get a chance to work in the Government  
Office, and I am ever so much thankful  
to you for writing to in such way which I  
never expected to here from the place where  
I was to school when I was nothing but a  
little boy and I will close my sort letters  
by thanking you for your kindness I remain
