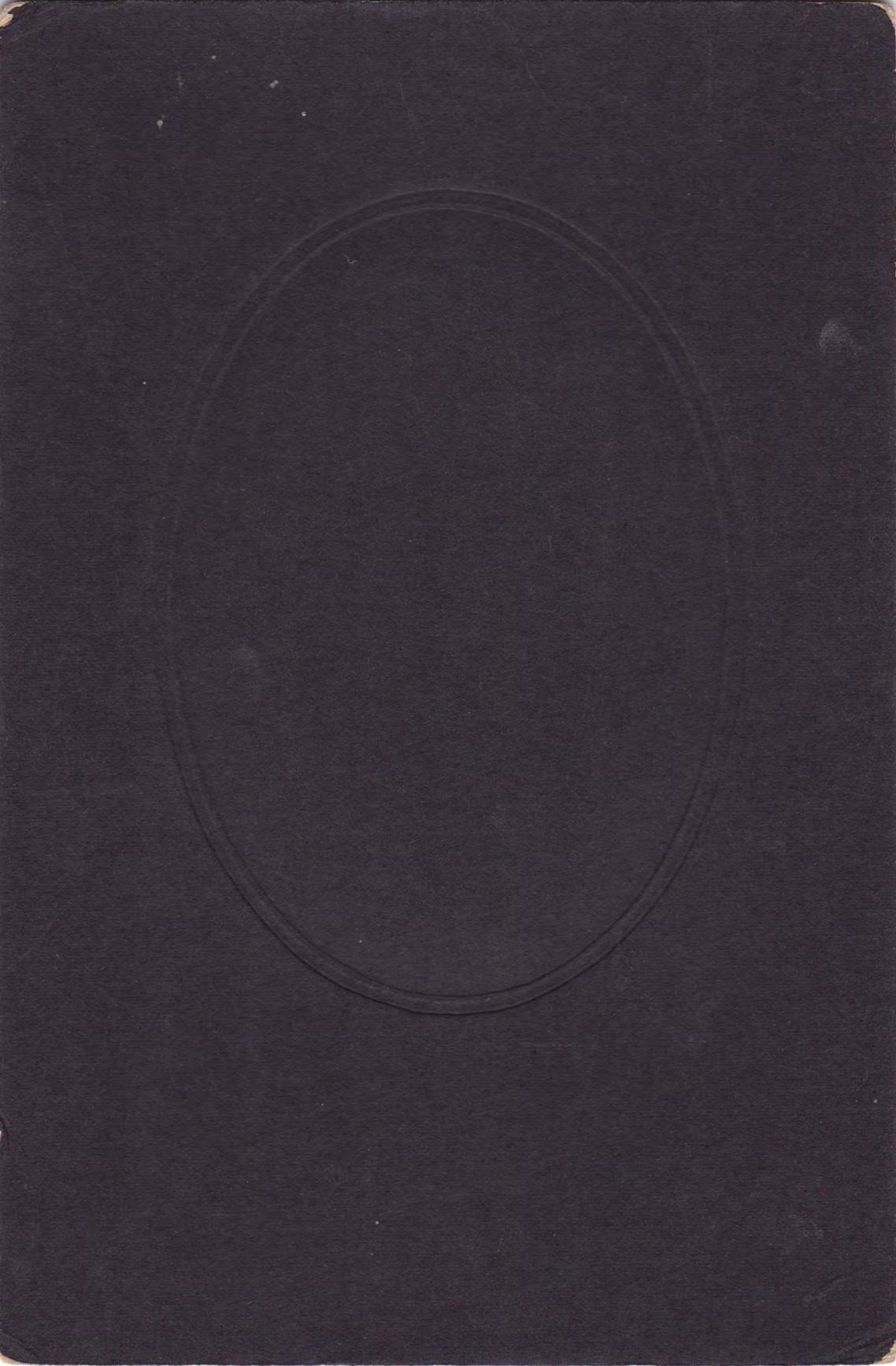

2. What is your present address? Klamath Falls, Oregon.
3. Did you attend or graduate from any other schools after leaving Carlisle? Give names of school and dates if possible. After my escape at Carlisle I attended Phornis in Arizona, I went there in Feb., '01, and graduated in the Spring of 1903.
4. What is your present occupation? Salary? My present occupation is the wood business through the saw also dealing in furs and run a dray
5. Do you own your home? I have the property but no house on it.
6. What kind of a house is it? Number of rooms? Saw paying rent, which amounts to \$18⁰⁰ per month
7. How much property do you possess? I have 800 acres of timber in my possession, and a 27 acre tract which intend to have my future home
- Stock 20 head of cattle and 4 head of work horses
- Land I have two wagons and ever thing that's required in house keeping time

10. What other positions have you held since leaving Carlisle? *none outside of working at the Printer's trade for a while.*

Not a great deal as I do not reside on the Reservation, but on many occasions I have given them advice on business dealings, that is to the best of my knowledge and since my marriage I have tried to set an example for the younger generation so called Indians and many of the Pale Face race also.

I am at present making my home in Keauwath Falls, Ore, which

has a future of being the metropolis
of Southern Oregon.

I have been married but a short
time and most of my time has
been devoted to home duties and business
affairs of my own.

After returning home from Phoenix
I went East and hired out as a ball-player
to Green's Nebraska
Indians, composed of returned students from
different schools, which toured the Eastern
States, but after the season returned home,
fell in love, lost all hopes in ball playing,
got married, ^{and} I have at present two
children a boy and a girl, I have been
married past three years and I am
happy and contented I hoping that I've
said enough It's clear I am sorry I didn't
answer sooner as I've been away from
home for the past three weeks enclosed find
a photograph of myself, hoping that
this will arrive in time
