I worked in the Tailoring Department, when I was a student at your school, but, I have not followed tailoring, as my occupation, for the simple reason of my fondness of outdoor life. I have been employed in different kinds of work. I have worked in the Lumbering Camps of the Adirondack Mts, for different concrete constructions companies in Canada. Last summer, I spent in Syracuse N.Y. working on a farm. I have covered, a large territory, working for different firms, since I came home. Mostly, I worked as a common laborer.
