While at Carlisle from 1841 to 1844

A large boy ran over my right foot trampled on it which resulted in blood poison, my leg amputated between foot and knee. That was my reason for returning home, poor health after my leg was cut off at that time being only 10 or 11 years of age I was greatly handicapped in my struggle of existence to support myself. I have been told by many, that having met with misfortune in the care of the Government, it would seem that the Government ought to by rights get me an artificial leg, - as long as I should be alive. The Government did get me a leg in 1902 when I was in Fort Lapwai school. So I take this opportunity to ask you to intercede for me to the Government and ask them if I could be helped by them. The leg cost \$5.00 at Washington D.C. at J. Hanger and Co. I hope to hear from you soon - Yours truly Lewis Perben.
