That God gave us this medicine, that by eating it he caused us to think of him & pray to him as we ought to. This I never did until I eat this medicine. now I pray to God every day. I found out that he only will help us if we only give our hearts to him. I have lead a life that I am not ashamed of since I eat this Peyote Medicine.
