The new town of Oneida which was opened last April

selected me as one of the three supervisors which is quite an honor since better educated men tried so hard for the position, it is rather hard studying up the laws of the county opening new roads, and building new bridges and still please everybody. There are almost as many white people as Indians live in this town. We had an election on the liquor question and only 18 voted for the saloon so I guess it will be a long time before we have a saloon here at that rate which is a very good thing.
