8. What other positions have you held since leaving Carlisle? *I been working on the farm every since I left Carlisle. I like to be amony with the whites all the time*

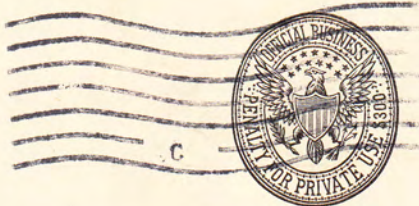
9. Tell me anything else of interest connected with your life: *Well every sence*
