But not if you dont want it to take me back, I will be satisfaction anyhow for me.

I have three sisters + three brothers and they are not care about my troubles. they does not willing to care of me, My mother are willing to take me but she is not able to take me right away home now. I am very anxious to get home who ever takes me home.
