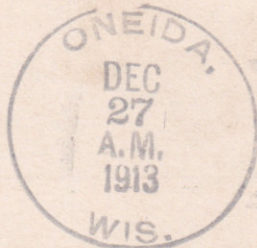

My dear Sir:

Upon receipt of your letter of the 25th instant a search was made thru the records at this school for information in regard to the amount of money you claim was left here by your son Elias.

It is noted in the accounts on file that in June of 1900 an amount of \$20.56 then to the credit of your son was turned over to the "Emergency Fund" that was then being used. At that time all deserters' money was taken up in that fund and was used for the good of the other students enrolled at Carlisle.
