I attend Carlisle school just six week and from there went back Haskell Inst. about four yrs. I spent there and I see when I was at Carlisle ~~at~~ September 1890

I was asst. disciplinarian at Haskell Inst. till 1894 then from there I went to Onida Boarding school, Onida Wis. as

Industrial teacher remained over five years, then from there went to Dak for 2 yrs then transferred again to Lac du Flambeau

for over four years and here I resigned from there just year ago last November, and I came back to West De Pere, Wis. to ~~live~~ ^{live} and I've been carpentering ever since, and got \$2.00 a day to start in

11. Have you done anything for the betterment of your people? Write fully.

I have never staid at home at any length of time since I quit school always away, and really for return student has not much to do on reservation for betterment. on account there is too many drawback i.e. to my standpoint at least with me and I am not farmer and cannot be all farmers, so I lease or rent my place in shares

12. Tell me anything else of interest connected with your life.

As for myself I have done great deal better for myself and my family to be away from my own people. I am some what funny ideas in many ways and there are quite a few families living in different towns near by here and all getting along well.

So you could see now all my ideas about this I left home in 1884 and I did not have any schooling then and not any English speaking in 1889 when I first got a chance to go to school then I began to learn in English Language. I was then past 21. I was born in 1866 and you can just guess what kind of a time I had to learn and I realized that the only chance I had to learn some thing and I took carpenter trade so now I am enjoying living from what I had learned in school
