Write fully. *yes, when I came back to Mother's home I fixed her log house I put the stone foundation lap siding and cornice all in good shape Build a stable for her. And I done some buildings there at Oneida while I wasn't doing anything at home.*

When I first went to school I could not speak a word of English at all. at that time I thought my mother was very mean to me because she send me away from home. but we all know that the boys have foolish thoughts, and now I will send you my family picture, if it wasn't for the Indian schools I couldn't be this way. all my children speak English only. I thank you very much for write me about this matter. I appreciate for what little education I have and it is my fault for not having the best education to be had in the Indian schools.
