No I never have been in the Indian Service.

I love my present occupation, farming. Last year I harvested 45 bus of potatoes from $\frac{1}{4}$ of an acre. on 5 acres I reaped 90 bus. of rye. from 8 acres of land I received 12 ton of hay. I received 40 bus. of oats from a small space the remaining is still in brush and timber.
