I have your favor of the 27th, requesting the balance of your money in bank and in reply would state there is \$108.30 to your credit in bank with interest to date.

Your record here of course you know does not entitle you to close out your account. From what we learn of you now, I am inclined to think you are trying to make good and in order to encourage you along these lines I am enclosing you a check, for \$ 50.00

Whether you will ever receive the balance depends upon yourself. The fact that you deserted from school should not in my mind be charged up against you as an unpardonable crime. When I am satisfied that you are doing your best, which of course will be a credit to Carlisle, I am willing that you shall have the remainder of your money.
