Dear Friend:-

Received your letter to day. Asking me by what name I was known when I was at Carlisle.

I was known as Juan at the time I was there.

But nevertheless I ought to be known as John in the first place.

Because Juan is a Spanish name, and Juan means John in English.

By the way my right name

ought to be John Thomas Lawker,
by rights.

Because the oldest of my family
name is Lawker.

At that time the Indian families
don't go by one name.

One family has a different
name at that time.

But they are getting so each
family goes by one name now.

The blank that I send you
has been at Sacaton over a year
and I did not get it till last
summer.

And the first one you send
I did not get it.

I made mistake in my address
it is Mineville instead Vineville

Although your letter reached
me alright - and found me O. K.
I was very much please to
hear from you.

Hope to hear from you
again some times.

Was married a short time to Flora Howard. She died shortly after our marriage.

2. What is your present address?

Vineville, Cal. of H. H. Luckensmeyer.

3. Did you attend or graduate from any other schools after leaving Carlisle? ^{No. 11} Give names of

schools and dates if possible

I did attend a Mission School in 1894 for a period of six months. But this was before I went to Carlisle.

4. What is your present occupation?

My present occupation is farming mostly.

5. Tell something of your present home

At present my home is ^{kind} of unsatisfactory to me, on account of water being scarce for the last few years. But I hope we will have plenty of water in ^{short} time.

6. What property in the way of land, stock, buildings or money do you have?

I have a land of which I call my own, which is 5 acres. Six head of horses and a team of mules.

7. Have you been in the Indian Service? In what positions? How long in each?

Have been as a helper in The Carpenter shop at one time for five months. At another time was a helper also in The garden for four months.

8. What other positions have you held since leaving Carlisle?

I held no other positions since leaving Carlisle only farming Rail Reading, and any other kind of common labor. But farming strikes better anything else.
