Mr. Lamason:-

I received your postal last week and was glad to hear from you.

I am glad your boys are going to have a chance to demonstrate plastering and bricklaying as each trade is an art if it is done right. By working in different parts of the State, I have had steady work up till February, since then, I have averaged two days in the week.

Work opens up all through the Southwest about the first of April. Our scale is six dollars per day and time and a half for over time and double time for legal holidays and Sundays.

I hope your boys will make good Union men when they leave school and do all in their power to protect the craft.
