One day I lay off from my work and went home on visit just the next I was home a sheriff after me he took me along and put in a lock up. This happen on the nineteen of march this year. And I kept on asking what going to done they wont gave me no kind of information. They took me on trial on 10th of april I told the best I can that I did not do any thing what I was arrest for. But He did not seem to believe me so I told them I can prove it if they give me chance but they did not they just simply accuse I plead guilty and they sentence for Auburn State Prison which I am at now. I am put in here for attempt rape they called it for not less then one year and more then three my interest thing are gone away from me on account of this thing happen. I have to begin new of over a year after I was realize from here. I like to write to the Indian office if only had their right address in this affair I dont think it right for not giving me a show to help myself I could got free from it easy enough if I had the chance
