7. Have you been in the Indian Service? In what positions? How long in each? I never was in Indian service.

8. What other positions have you held since leaving Carlisle?

Nothing much
only a clerk of this District.

9. Tell me anything else of interest connected with your life:

Well I don't know of anything much
only I raise hogs and have a nice bunch
of 10 head at about 150 lbs a piece.
and about 100 hens and we market
about 12 doz. eggs ~~at~~ a week and
about 10 or 12 lbs of butter a week
which just about make our living.

I raise corn mostly and some
cane and millet, and a little
alfalfa. I never received your
letter that you sent me.
