INDORSEMENT.

A child showing one-sixteenth or less Indian blood, whose parents live on an Indian reservation, Indian fashion, who, if debarred from the Government schools, could not obtain an education, may be permitted in the reservation day and boarding schools, but it is preferable that it be not transferred to a nonreservation school, without special permission from the Office. Children showing one-eighth or less Indian blood, whose parents do not live on an Indian reservation, whose home is among white people where there are churches and schools, who are presumed to have adopted the white man's manners and customs, and are to all intents and purposes white people, are debarred from enrollment in the Government nonreservation and reservation schools. Superintendents, in all cases where doubt exists as to the degree of Indian blood of a child proposed for transfer, should fully satisfy themselves of the facts by affidavits from reliable persons, which affidavits must be kept on file at the school.

A pupil who has been regularly enrolled in a nonreservation school must not be taken to any other nonreservation school without the consent of both Superintendents and the Commissioner of Indian Affairs, and Superintendents will be held to strict accountability for such pupils taken to their schools.

A pupil dismissed from school for cause must not be enrolled in any other school without the permission of the Commissioner of Indian Affairs. Full facts must be submitted with each request.

5. Tell something of your present home. Shanagolden is a small lumbering town. There are several camps near us and we visit them real often and enjoy going.

6. What property in the way of land, stock, buildings, or money do you have? none

7. Have you been in the Indian Service? In what positions? How long in each? no.

8. What other positions have you held since leaving Carlisle?.....

9. Tell me anything else of interest connected with your life: My uncle is foreman in the camp nearest Town only three miles from here, my father and younger brother are also employed there.

In camp there are over ninety men working, and twenty four horses are used for hauling and skidding the logs, the logs are hauled to the nearest railroad by a steam log hauler over a road that is as smooth as glass. Every night two teams are used to haul a large sprinkler over this road, and it is so cold here the water freezes immediately making the road like glass.

A week after I left Carlisle, my mother died and I kept house for my father and brother all summer, I got along very nicely. In the spring I shall go back to Shawano and help house for them again.
