Several Indians were candidates for county offices, Edward G. Battle-yon was elected county auditor, Clarence Three Stars and Edgar Fire Thunder were elected members of the board of county Commissioners, Oscar Amiotte coroner, and Trouble in Front, Charles Red Bear and Howard Bad Wound justices of the peace.
