Full-Blooded Sioux, Educated at Carlisle Seeks Work Among the Whites in Greeley

Having been given, as the ward of the white man's government, some degree of education, a full blooded Sioux now seeks a chance to work in the white man's way, so that he may use the knowledge acquired, and not revert to the habits of his forefathers.

Narcise Prettyface, 27 years old, born on the Crow Creek Indian reservation, north of Chamberlain on the Missouri river, is a graduate of the Carlisle school and was subsequently employed for three years in Galien, Ohio, personifies a problem, and puts the solution up to the white men who now own the land, who limited his freedom with their civilization and who gave him aspirations toward a different life than his ancestors knew, with their academic and mechanical education.

Four years ago he married, his bride being a halfbreed, part Sioux and part Mexican. They have two children, a girl and a boy, and he has brought his family together with his wife's sister, to Greeley, where he seeks employment on a farm or a stock ranch or in any capacity for which his training qualifies him. Temporarily, they are living with Roy Martinez, on Seventh street.

His wife, in common with most of the women of her race, is an expert at beadwork and Prettyface exhibits samples of her skill which he hopes to sell pending the day when he can begin supporting his family by the sweat of his brow—in the envied fashion of the white man, whose ways he has learned and whose example he would emulate.
