I hereby certify that the statements made in the foregoing application and certificate, to the best of my knowledge and belief, are true; that the consent of Rev Balliste Kurbert (Parent, guardian, or next of kin.)
was voluntary, and I recommend the transfer of the said child.

SPECIAL NOTE.

This form must be executed in duplicate when a child is transferred from a reservation to a nonreservation school. The Superintendent of the nonreservation school will retain the original for his files, and the duplicate shall be deposited in the Agency records. The agent will then send to the Commissioner of Indian Affairs his certificate as provided by law. All the blanks must be properly filled in every case.

NOTE

Age limits, fourteen to twenty years. Preferably fourteen to eighteen. Students must be at least one-fourth Indian, preferably full Indian. Special cases beyond the age limit will be given consideration. An industrial course only can be taken and the term reduced to three years, in exceptional cases.

INDORSEMENTS

The laws relating to the transfer of Indian children from reservations and schools are as follows:

That hereafter no Indian child shall be sent from any Indian reservation to a school beyond the State or Territe in which said reservation is situated without the voluntary consent of the father or mother of such child if either them are living, and if neither of them are living without the voluntary consent of the next of kin of such child. Such consent shall be made before the agent of the reservation, and he shall send to the Commissioner of Indian Affairs certificate that such consent has been voluntarily given before such child shall be removed from such reservation. A it shall be unlawful for any Indian agent or other employee of the Government to induce, or seek to induce, by with holding rations or by other improper means, the parents or next of kin of any Indian to consent to the removal of a Indian child beyond the limits of any reservation. (28 Stats., p. 906.)

Provided, That hereafter no Indian child shall be taken from any school in any State or Territory to a school in a other State against its will or without the written consent of its parents. (29 Stats., p. 348.)

The rules provide that-

A pupil who has been regularly enrolled in a nonreservation school must not be taken to any other nonreservative school without the consent of both Superintendents and the Commissioner of Indian Affairs, and Superintendents when the held to strict accountability for such pupils taken to their schools.

An Indian boy or girl 18 years old and over may, without the consent of parents or others, personally sign application form on its being changed to suit the case.

This form is to be used only in transfers from reservations or Indian schools to nonreservation schools.
