8. What other positions have you held since leaving Carlisle? I was official interpreter Yankton Agency for about two or three years.

9. Tell me anything else of interest connected with your life:

I am now farming for two years on the reservation. Last year I broke 160 acres of land belong to aged Indians who are unable to farm themselves, for the used of land. I get two crop for my trouble, next year they get $\frac{1}{3}$ of the crop. I used steam plowing outfit and break 12 acres per day.

Last fall I sold \$1800⁰⁰/₁₀₀ worth flax from the first crop, and this year I sowed 80^{acres} wheat, 80 acres oats, 20 acres of corn, 30 acres of flax.

This spring I farm 210 acres in all. I am ~~try~~ trying to set the example that the man in overalls is the man get bread and butter and builder of his country.
