very obligi to you.

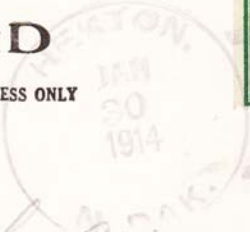

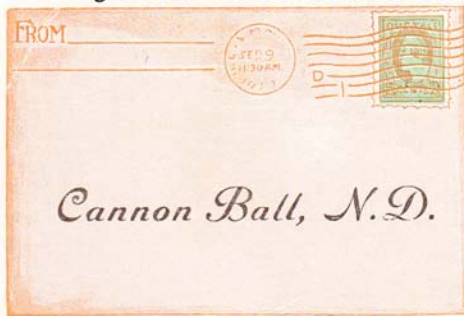

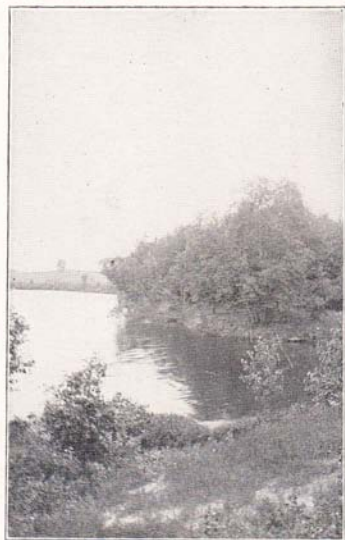
