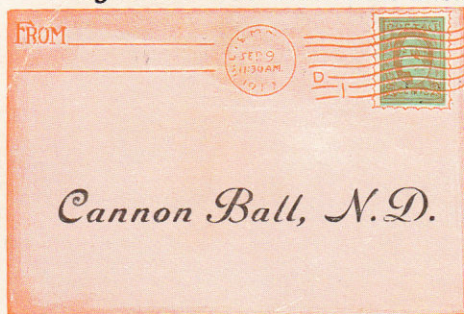
Rec'd that

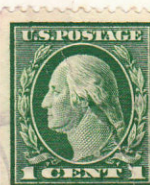
