My dear Mr Friedman,

In regards to yesterdays report which I ^{have} mailed you, I must state that I have carelessly omitted a question where it refers to land owned by me.

We have been allotted 1920 acres of grazing land, 200 acres of agricultural land of the first class, 20 acres of timber land.

None of this land is broken for farming purposes yet, we expect about 40 acres broken next Spring.

I must state that majority of the Carlisle Returned Students are doing nicely.

Since my return from Carlisle we have had several different Indian Agents here, but none of them seemed to take interest in the

(Date.)

Indians, our present Agent towers above all of them. I don't think the Indian Department could find any better man than he is. He has purchased traction engines for breaking land, seeds and every thing a Farmer needs for farming and I am sure in few years the Indians will be on their feet again.
