7. Have you been in the Indian Service? In what positions? How long in each? No.

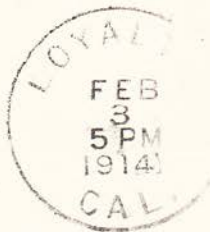
8. What other positions have you held since leaving Carlisle? I held several good positions as clerk and as lumber inspector, etc.
