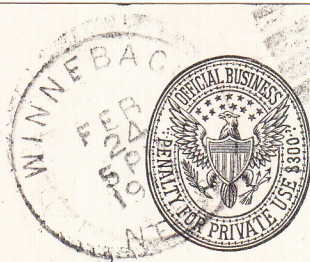
Dear friend
