6. What property in the way of land, stock, buildings, or money do you have? I have 160 acres of land on which I get \$102 a year.

7. Have you been in the Indian Service? In what positions? How long in each? I entered the Indian Service Sept. 9-1910 as an assistant matron.

8. What other positions have you held since leaving Carlisle?

After leaving Carlisle in 1909, I worked in a very nice family at Anadarko, and through a kind friend, I got the position I am now in.

9. Tell me anything else of interest connected with your life:

After leaving Carlisle my sister and I went and spend the summer with our Aunt, in the fall - here we went to Chillico, and I was left alone. I was lonesome and longed to be back at Carlisle. I could not stand it any longer, so I wrote to the Agency to help me get a place to work, in a few days I received a word from them to come that they had a nice place for me. I stayed there until Sept. 9-1910 and through a kind friend I got the position I am in now. I like my work very much as an assistant nation, I am trying to do the best I can, I am thankful for what the Indian School at Carlisle has done for me, and the training I received.
