My dear Friend:

Your letter of the 29th ultimo has been received and we are pleased to have the report from you that you are located in a home of your own and that you have three children to care for and train. It is hoped you have had many opportunities to make use of the training you were given when you were a student at Carlisle.

It is gratifying to know you have thought of this school as a suitable place for the education of those of your friends who are planning to attend a school away from home next year, but authority for the enrolment would probably have to be secured from the Commissioner of Indian Affairs because, more and more, entrance is being denied the girls and boys who have access to public schools near their homes.

Herewith blanks are being enclosed upon which applications for enrolment may be submitted for consideration, but before the expense of having them properly executed is incurred it will be well to write further particulars in
