8. What other positions have you held since leaving Carlisle? *never held no position. I didn't have some cattle and good horse, when my father was living and was well fixed, but this time I didn't*

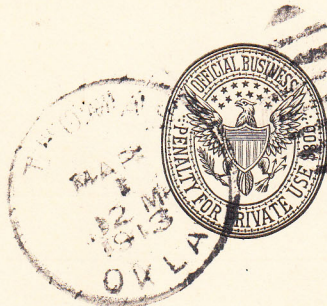
9. Tell me anything else of interest connected with your life:
