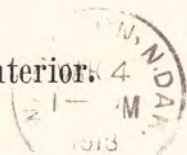

I've been in the Indian Service, first at Island Grove, South Dakota, as assistant cook, remaining there 6 months then received a promotion to cook, at Ponemah, Minn under the Red Lake Agency, remaining there 5 months then resigned, and then sent here temporarily, since Oct. '09.

from there went in the Service as
described below.

Since I left, my two dear old
Indian Schools, Carlisle and Haskell
I found many interesting, and

and many times would have failed
if not for my Education, got at these
two good Institutions, since I had
pupils under me, I can see now
why my teachers, and matrons were
so severe, and wish many times I had
done better toward them, but I look
back, and do as they taught me.

I am well satisfied with
my present position here as nurse.
There are three old Carlisle students
Miss Augusta Nash, our efficient seamstress
John Luskier, the Dispensarian, and
our Rupt is a Haskell man, (N. B. Ham)
