of her father or other relative.

She has not lived with her father  
for many years.

She entered Carlisle Indian School  
of her own choice and volition. She is  
past fifteen years of age and has  
not been under a relative's control  
for at least six years. I think this  
qualifies her to act for herself.

If she has a home, it is Hayward  
Training School, and I have been her  
guardian by her choice and by the  
consent of her father for more than  
four years. I freely consent to her  
enrollment at Carlisle for a term of  
either three or five years, and commend  
her as a very worthy and excellent  
young woman.

Sir:-

I inclose herewith application of Theresa Connor, who has for more than four years been a pupil and employee of this school.

Theresa is practically homeless. Her father lives in the wilds of Minnesota. She visited him two years ago, but could not adapt herself to his mode of life, and returned to our school to remain indefinitely. I think her father agreed to permit her to attend any school, that was satisfactory to me. You can determine this by conversing with her.

She is not in charge of Major Campbell of the LaPointe Agency, and his name to the consent blank does not grant any authority for her enrollment. She has never lived on a reservation, but her mother, now deceased, was allotted on the Vermillion Lake Reservation.

She is a good girl, and I trust will profit by her attendance at your school. We found her trustworthy in every way. She was for a year, Asst. Seamstress here, and for three months, Baker. She was very successful as Asst. Seamstress, but she has not had the training or experience necessary to make a good Baker, and she resigned.

I think you will have no trouble about her attendance for the full term of her enrollment. Please permit her to choose the branch of training she prefers, and I feel quite sure that she will fit herself for self support.
