To show this fact to the interested public in a convincing form, I purpose to issue, before long, a pamphlet giving photographs of the homes of some of our representative graduates and ex-students. I want YOUR help in this attempt. I understand you own a good comfortable home. May I ask that you send me a photograph of your home to be used for the purpose above named. I will appreciate your aid, and will be glad to return the photograph after I have had a cut made from it. I am living in a good, costly, neat home with my little family. My husband is one of the employees of Indians Department, head of the Crow Indians cattle getting good wages. He is a good intelligent man for any occupation. I have our little girl attend school at Saint Xavier Mission 12 years old. my oldest boy died eleven years ago. I wish you would get a chance to come and see our little cottage fix like a home. my husband has about over one hundred and fifty head of cattle on our ranch. good teams to work with to broke the field with it - he payed one team for \$450.00 and the team he payed \$350.00 and a pair of mares cost him about \$250.00. this year he plowed 40 acres of oats and wheat and put up about 80 tons of hay. I am enclosed you our picture.
