Under those circumstances I will not ask you to give the names of students as was requested under recent date. However, if there are any who can meet the requirements mentioned above I will be pleased to have you refer them to me.

Allow me to explain that the communication that was addressed to you some time ago was one of many similar ones that was sent to our graduates and former students and that it was not noted that you are a member of the Five Civilized Tribes.
