but I had to come home I had been out working
on account of my sickness until a few months ago
but I'll soon be able I think when I was taken very
too grand work again but ill, then I lost my job
not for the same family and all the money I had
as they got a girl, when saved, I was in San Diego
they learned I could not in the hospital for three
return to them very weeks, in bed, I thought
soon, it is almost a year sure I was not going
ago, since I have been home to get well but, I am
ever since I returned I on my way to recovery
went to a night school and I hope I'll not get
in San Diego, I tried to sick again for a long time
get through but I did not to come. I worked for

because my eyes bother
me a great deal, so I had
to give up. We are harrow
ing our beans and corn
just now, we expect to
sell our corn before next
fall, I think we will
be husking corn some
time this week or next.
