4. What is your present occupation? House-keeping for my husband on a claim in S. Dak.

5. Tell something of your present home My husband filed on a claim out here in June and we came out here from Feb. to in Aug. 1910. to live on the claim

6. What property in the way of land, stock, buildings or money do you have? I have some real estate in Neb., some money in a bank here and quarter section of home stead land + stock

7. Have you been in the Indian Service? In what positions? How long in each?

Yes. I held the position of Asst. Master at Cheyenne River S.D. two years and at Omaha Agency one year.

8. What other positions have you held since leaving Carlisle? I was Bakery at the Chamberlain, S.D. a year. My health failed me I resigned in 1904. We were married in the year 1905.

9. Tell me anything else of interest connected with your life:

My husband has not gotten his allotment as an Indian yet. He has made application to the Indian Office to be adopted at the Pine Ridge Agency S.D. as a member of the tribe and draw his allotment. He was taken away from his people when a small boy and raised by white people. His mother died in that time at Pine Ridge where her people now live. Frank has gotten affidavits made out and signed by the different members of the counsel men and sent them to Washington. Could you not use your influence to push the matter a long if you can, it would be appreciated gratefully. I for my ^{self} was unlucky too with my folks, did not draw any benefits of my Indian blood of Omaha tribe. We are doing better than most of the Indians to earn the bread by the sweat of the brow.
