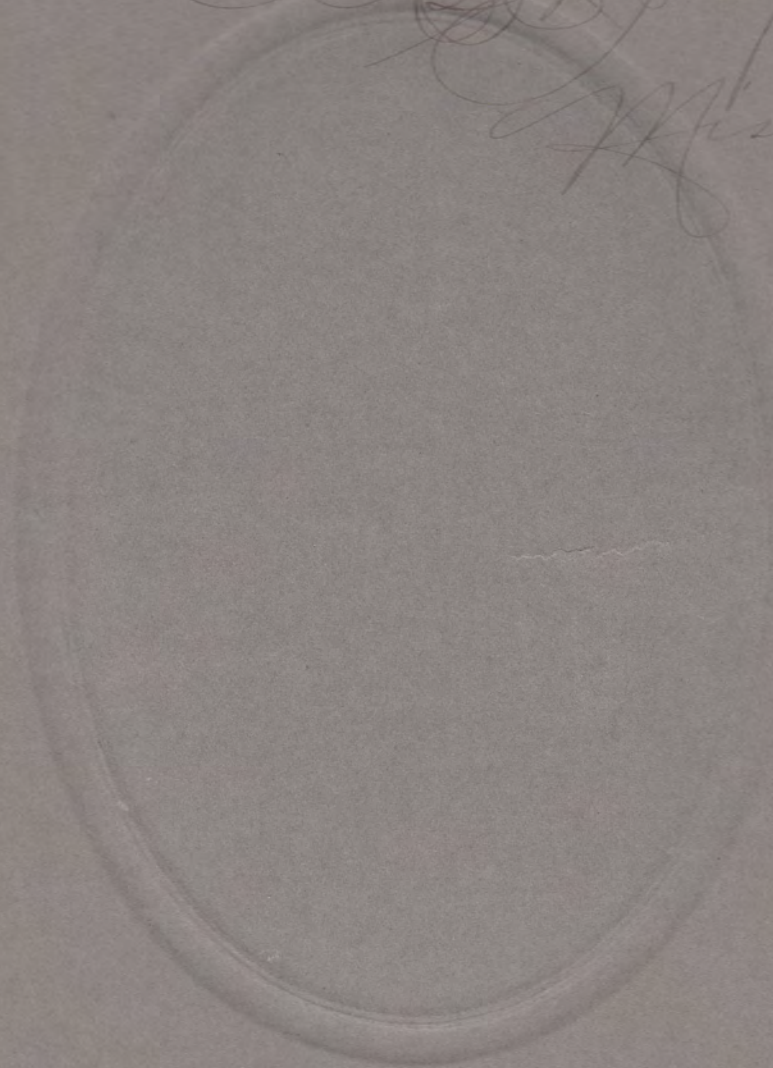

"Does it pay to educate the Indian?" This question means a great deal. You can only take those who ask the question to the Indian Reservations all over the U.S. Let them study up the tribe ten twenty years ago & just compare it of to day. I have take the principle draw backs such as whisky. The "Dead Beat whites" and low set of whites whose influence has been a draw back to a returned student in many ways. I say in be half of the Omaha tribe. It pays to educate the Indian with his own money. But to make a success the whites have to be educated first. You will find when the Indian money is intirely gone there wont be any questions asked.
