Well, I think nursing is the grandest thing for girls to know how to take care of the sick in their own family, or to the others. I know I never regreted that I did learn nursing although I did not take up nursing after my graduation at the Conn. Training school for nurses in Connecticut, except one year. Then household duties came on and have a family of seven to take care of, it's a great help to me. Two of my oldest children are in the Tomah Indian school now, which I expect to send them to Carlisle in the future. I am sorry I could not be present at your Commencement time, but I hope some day I will visit Carlisle again. We have a small farm at present, my husband is quite interested in saw mills in the north.
