I thank you for your favor of August the 8th, containing the names of Elizabeth and Mandelene Skenandore and Lidia and Amerson Metoxen, prospective students for Carlisle who could be recommended because of the good records they have made. I have noted, however, that the young people are between the ages of thirteen and fourteen and so they cannot be received here this year. It is now a law that students must be fourteen years of age before they can be received at a non-reservation school, except they are sent on with older children from the same family and their transportation is provided by their parents.
