Will you let me hear from you if further assistance can be given in the matter from this end?

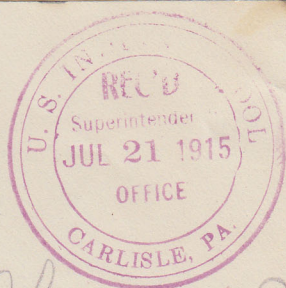
Our school printer has been requested to have your copy of the ARROW addressed to you hereafter at Abrams, Wisconsin, as is desired by you.
