2. What is your present address? Owyhee, Nevada.

3. Did you attend or graduate from any other schools after leaving Carlisle? No. Give names of schools and dates if possible

4. What is your present occupation? Housekeeping.

5. Tell something of your present home. We have quite a good sized farm here in the Duck Valley Reservation on which my husband has built a house, which is quite comfortable, all raises hay mostly here on this Res. My husband had a very good crop last year and he sold about \$200.00 worth.

6. What property in the way of land, stock, buildings, or money do you have? We have a good sized farm with buildings on it. However our Reservation is not allotted yet. We have a small herd of cattle of about ten head and about twice that many head of horses, which we have accumulated since we have been married.

7. Have you been in the Indian Service? In what positions? How long in each? I have never worked in the Indian service.

8. What other positions have you held since leaving Carlisle?.....

None I did not feel strong enough to do much work after returning home.

9. Tell me anything else of interest connected with your life:

I returned from school in June of 1906. I was married to Mr. Ebe on Christmas Eve of the same year. We have three little children. My oldest, is a little girl past two years old, she is a bright healthy child. We call her Abbie. We have twin boys past four months old, which we have named Paul and Claud. They are stardy little fellows and we mean to bring them up an honor to the service which has been such a help to us. We hope they may some day attend the school which was a help to me.

My husband is an industrious ~~property~~ ^{energetic} man. He speak English.

He makes us a good living and we are accumulating property. He speak English as well as I do myself. He ^{has} attended school among the whites to some extend.
