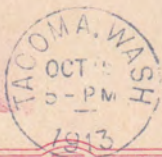

We left Dulalip on account of so many inconvenient things, we had one small room a great deal smaller than the girls rooms at Carlisle and just because we were from "Dear Old Carlisle" we "got it in the neck" as they say but we stood for C.I.S. and now Ralph is working as a carpenter making \$21 a week and we save more here than we did there. Ralph wants to get back in the service this fall again, he had an appointment to go to Hayward Wis, but I was very sick and he could not leave me. Is there any position open there?
