Dear friend Nora:

You will be surprised to hear from me, no doubt, but I want a bit of information.

You have heard 'ere this that I am back at Carlisle again. It seems that I can't stay away from here. This must be the place where I am to do my work. I am now in the office that Miss Ely used to have and I have her position. You may remember that she had charge of the Outing pupils.

Carlisle has changed considerably. Its buildings are more numerous and more modern, of course, but the old Girls' Quarters and Teachers' Quarters are the same as ever with but very little change in them. The two Boys' Quarters are the same. The employees have all changed with the exception of two or three. Mr. Kensler, the man who used to have charge of the storehouse is still here. I am very happy in my work here and feel that I can do a great deal of good for my race in a quiet way.

We are looking up the ex-students and want to find out as much as we can about them. Every boy and girl that ever went to school here are listed among our students and each has a card and pocket in the files. To those whose addresses we have we send them the weekly paper printed here, called the Arrow. I shall be glad to hear from you in regard to this matter. I have the idea that Mary, your sister, is dead. If I am right please let me know, giving the date of her death as nearly as you can, also anything about any other Carlisle student that you happen to know about.
