I myself never had - but am educating my girl to take over

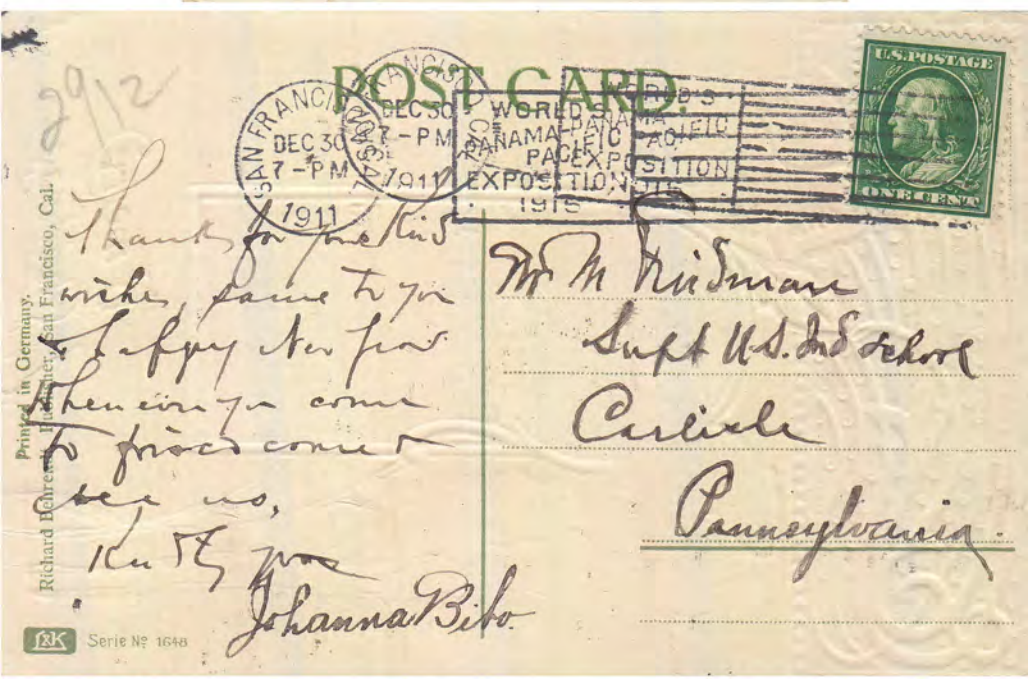
8. What other positions have you held since leaving Carlisle?
