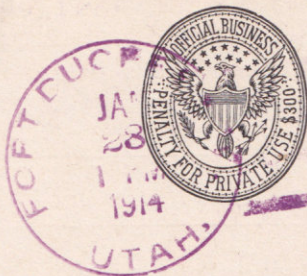

We had a nice big team when Mr Cobb & I were married but we lost both they just got sick & died. We felt lost with out a team but we just kept courage up, and now we have another team I am glad to say.

I am the proud mother of to little boys. the oldest one

Loyde will be four years old next April and Manfred will be two yrs next Sept. Mr Cobb & I are very proud of them. They are so cute. We wouldn't know without them, my brother Albert has also two boys, his is also going to move on his allotment in the Spring.
