Found patron had not conformed to the rules of the school. Permitted Rosie to remain out till 8 or 9 o'clock without knowing where she was. When she, with two other Indian girls met white boy in the park. Boy walked home with them. Rosie with another Indian girl went with to a park in the afternoon six miles away and patron knew nothing of it. As the Patron has not given the girls proper protection, she should be dropped.
