Second Visit

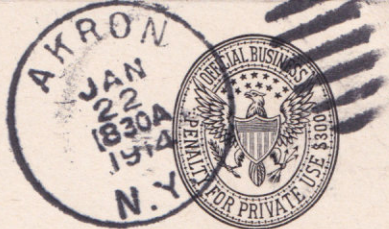
Patron says Roxie is satisfactory and she has increased her wages to \$10.00.

Found patron had not conformed to the rules of the school. Permitted Roxie to remain out till 8 or 9 o'clock without knowing where she was. When she, with two other Indian girls met white boys in the park. Boys walked home with them. Roxie with another Indian girl went with to a park in the afternoon six miles away, and patron knew nothing of it. As the Patron has not given the girls proper protection, she should be dropped.
