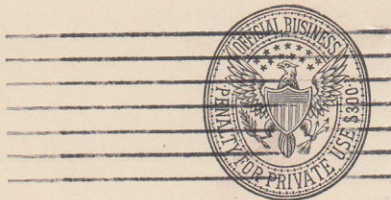
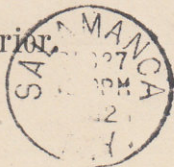
The year after leaving Carlisle I attended a District School for one year and since I have worked in private families at different places.

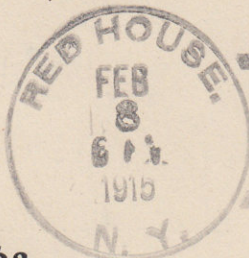
