we got here just as good as his

out side. They use to get 1.50 day  
if we can afford it to have them  
come home during the vacation  
I have all the work for them to  
do and after haying they can work  
out for themselves. we would kindly  
like to know how much it would  
cost to have them come home

one day you call Willie & on  
 side and ask him if he  
 would give solo on his  
 Trombone with his feet.  
 if he will. he would have to  
 practice a little. regarding to  
 the Perglases of Willie's we will  
 settle that as soon as I get better
